Guidelines for Contributors

Submission of Manuscript: Manuscript should be in English only on one side of good quality paper, with attachment to Editor journal.expression@gmail.com. The manuscript must have neither be published nor be adequate margin on all four sides. It must be complete in all respects such as abstract, illustrations, appendices etc.

Preparation of Manuscript : Manuscript should be presented in as concise a form as possible. Pages should be numbered consecutively and arranged in following order.

Title: the title should to brief nor unnecessarily long. It should reflect the content of the paper so as to derive the maximum advantage in indexing.

Abstract: The abstract, usually not exceeding 200 words, should indicate the scope and significant content of the paper, highlighting the principal findings and conclusion. It should be in such a form that abstracting can use it without modification.

Introduction: Long and elaborate introduction should be avoided. It should be brief and state the exact scope of periodicals can use it without modification. the study in relation to the present status of knowledge in the field.

Figure: Figures should be numbered in order of mention in the text. Each figure should have a descriptive name.

Mathematical Expression: Wherever possible, mathematical expressions should be spewritten, subscripts and superscripts clearly shown. It is helpful to identify ambiguous symbols in the when they first occur. Equations must be displayed exactly as they should appear in print and numbered in parentheses placed at the right margin.

Tables: Tables should have short descriptive caption and numbered consecutively

References: References must be prepared in proper format
