The formal meeting started with a welcome note by the IQAC Coordinator. The Chairperson requested all the members for an open house discussion on various Agendas & issues of the Meeting.

Agenda-wise Minutes are noted here as under

- IQAC coordinator Prof. Subodh Bala Gupta confirmed that AQAR 2019-20 has been submitted on 02 April 2021 with the combined efforts of the IQAC Team. The Principal congratulated all the IQAC members and recommended the start of the next AQAR 2020-21. It was proposed by Dr. Kanak Rani to add one member from each department to the IQAC committee to help in the procurement of official data. It was also discussed that all the suggestions given by the IQAC Coordinator should be incorporated by the criterion SPOC's person. The suggestion was approved by all unanimously.
- Chairperson Dr. Nisha Singh instructed all the Departmental Heads to finalize the Academic Calendar, Activity Calendar, and Time-Table for the session 2021-2022 and submit it by 15th July in the Principal's office before the commencement of the new academic session to ensure the smooth running of the session without any interruption.
- It was proposed by Teacher Representative Arvind Kr. Pandey to implement the strategies for the student development system in a more effective manner from the new academic session. Some other decisions were taken regarding this by IQAC members such as focusing on more Skill-Development courses department-wise, conducting more Industrial Visits to reputed organizations, and engaging students in more co-curricular activities under different clubs. It was unanimously resolved to go through the proposal.

• It was decided that the faculty members shall submit the previous session course file of their concerned subjects. The file (as and when required) must be submitted to the Principal's office by 20th July. It was decided that the IQAC coordinator shall provide a standard format for Lecture Plans to all the departments before the commencement of the next academic session

as per the NAAC guidelines.

• It was proposed by the Secretary Mr. Vineet Goel to all the Heads of the Departments to emphasize the use of more ICT tools and encourage students to obtain online certifications via MOOCs in their respective streams. It was also proposed that real-time assignments should be

given to students for more industrial exposure & skill development.

• The nominee from the local society Dr. Aruna Sharma proposed that a Course Exit Survey should be conducted for final-year students and a Students Feedback proforma should also be developed by the concerned Departmental Head. It was unanimously resolved by the members that Proforma for Alumni feedback should be drafted and finalized. The responsibility of this

was handed over to the Alumni committee coordinator Dr. Rekha Sharma.

• The policy of mentor-mentee was reviewed by IQAC members. Teacher Representative Dr. Dhiraj Singh proposed that the mentor-mentee ratio should be in accordance with the NAAC guidelines. It was also suggested that all the meetings should be held regularly and as stipulated. It was unanimously resolved by the members to focus on resolving the academic

problems of mentees and raising their potential to the maximum.

- It was proposed by the IQAC coordinator Dr. Subodh Bala Gupta to revise the Research Policy in accordance with the New Education Policy. It was unanimously resolved by the members to assign students projects & assignments that are research-based. Dissertation topics of M.Ed. students should also be assigned accordingly and students should be encouraged to get it published in reputed Journals (UG.C. care listed) in co-authorship with their respective supervisor.
- The last date to submit papers for M.C.P.S. Journal 'Expression' January 22 volume was decided as 31st November 2021. The Chairperson Dr. Nisha Singh assigned the responsibility for the Journal's upcoming issue to Dr. Kiran Joshi and Teacher Representative Dr. Dhiraj Singh. It was also instructed that only quality and plagiarism-free research papers would be accepted.
- Teacher Representative Mr. Arvind Kr. Pandey proposed an increased focus on using technology to ensure an effective teaching-learning process. It was also advised to increase the use of online teaching platforms for ensuring interactive learning.
- The IQAC members suggested that the Alumni committee should maintain a record of alumni along with their details including higher studies and placement in accordance with the NAAC guidelines. HODs must ensure that special lectures on personality development and communication skills are conducted regularly in the departments so as to upgrade employability skills. A particular slot in the timetable must be allotted for such lectures.
- It was proposed in the meeting by Teacher Representative Dr. Kanak Rani that a college Newsletter should be published quarterly. The chairperson finalized the name of the

newsletter as 'Modern *Times*'. It was suggested that the achievements of the Faculties and the students should be covered. Teacher representative Dr. Dhiraj Singh suggested the name of Mrs. Haritima Dixit for the post of Chief Editor of the Newsletter.

• It was also discussed that new initiatives for quality improvement shall be taken up by HODs in the departments in the upcoming academic session. Departments should focus more on organizing workshops on intellectual property rights, seminars, and extension lectures on values and ethics, cultural and sports activities, etc.

The formal meeting started with a welcome note by the IQAC Coordinator Prof. Subodh Bala Gupta. The Chairperson requested all the members for an open house discussion on various Agendas of the Meeting.

Agenda-wise Minutes are noted here as under

- It was proposed by the Chairperson Dr. Nisha Singh that a two-day National Seminar shall be organized by the Department of Education in the month of April. The theme was suggested by teacher representative Dr. Kanak Rani as "75 Years of Independence: Achievements, Challenges, and Opportunities.". The dates were finalized to be 8th- 9th April 2022. It was unanimously resolved by the members to present the proposal for the Seminar by 20th Feb. IQAC coordinator asked teacher representative Dr. Dhiraj Singh to take organizing a quality seminar a priority. Dr. Rekha Sharma and Dr. Babita Chaudhary were chosen as the coordinators for the national seminar.
- The problems faced in data collection in each criterion were discussed by the IQAC Coordinator
 with the members. It was suggested that the data should be compiled on a priority basis for
 ensuring the timely completion of AQAR 20-21. It was decided that a detailed report of the status
 of AQAR completion should be submitted latest by 15th march 2022.
 - It was proposed by Dr. Aruna Sharma that the college should offer some Value added courses in addition to the academic ones. It was unanimously resolved by the members to commence Value added courses on Interior Decoration, Language & communication skill Development, Web Designing, Banking Products and Practice, Productivity and Time Management, Focus, and Success, etc. for the students.

• The Secretary Mr. Vincet Goel suggested focusing on thrust areas of Research & Development. All heads of the Department were asked to ensure the participation of teachers in workshops, faculty development programs, and Guest lectures to enhance their existing skill set. Teacher Representatives Dr. Vineet Garg & Dr. Kanak Rani suggested a set of themes (Gender Roles, Human Values, Entrepreneurship management & Data Management) for a Guest Lectures Series. It was also suggested that the use of e-resources should be increased to develop a culture of independent learning and research in students.

• The last date for submission of the Research Paper for the July edition of the college Journal 'Expression' (International Journal of Social Science, Volume VIII, Issue II) was finalized to be 15th June 2022. It was advised by teacher representative Dr. Vineet Garg to get "EXPRESSION" enlisted in the UGC care list and make efforts for issuing an E-Journal with ISSN in the future.

• It was proposed by a nominee from industry and stakeholders Mr. Tejveer Chauhan to begin publication of a student E-Reflective Journal from the new academic session. The Chair Person, Dr. Nisha Singh suggested the name for the journal to be 'SAMVID'. The medium for the journal was decided to be both English as well as Hindi. Teacher Representative Dr. Dhiraj Singh recommended the name of Mrs. Haritima Dixit for the post of chief editor of the e-reflective journal. The recommendation was unanimously approved.

• The Chairperson suggested that all the HODs shall arrange for remedial classes and provide additional aid to slow learners (identified on the basis of performance in internal examination). It was also suggested that extra effort should be put into advanced learners so that they can secure a position in the university merit list. It was unanimously resolved by the members that regular meetings should be conducted with meritorious students to motivate and resolve any issues faced by them. A separate timetable to be prepared for remedial classes was also proposed.
