## Section 1: Infrastructure

- Physical infrastructure

### Academic Block

The academic block comprises 32 classrooms equipped with LCD Projectors and different types of laboratories. The entire academic block is wifi enabled and equipped with ultramodern facilities. Block contains one multipurpose hall of 2000 sqft. to conduct various types of in-house activities.

### Administrative Block

The Admin Block houses offices of the Principal, Secretary, Registrar, College Administration, Accounts Section, Teachers' Staff Rooms and Seminar Room with 5 multi-purpose small rooms. At the entry of the Admin Block a reception area welcomes the students, staff and other persons who seek to enquire about the college. The reception would be provided with an entire staff, with telephone and computer facility. The whole block has been specially painted and provided with new modular furniture. A pantry has also been provided in the Block.

Smart class nowadays is the essence of college. In this concern, the college has set up a SMART CLASS which provides e-learning e-lecture and media presentations to the students.

### Cafeteria

Our college campus has a cafeteria that runs during working hours and provides healthy and hygienic food to students and all staff members. A light and heavy menu are available during lunch hours at reasonable prices. Packed items are available on MRP. The students can avail of tea, coffee, and snacks from the cafeteria. The canteen facility is housed within the college campus and provides space for sitting and chatting over a cup of tea or coffee.

### Language Lab

The twenty-one-terminal lab is equipped with the latest, automated language lab system having the facility of voice recording, playback, one-on-one interaction etc. It is extremely beneficial for language learning and the enhancement of effective communication skills. The language lab is powered by Orell's digital language lab.

### Psychology Lab

The Psychology Laboratories at College has a large collection of psychological tests/ batteries and instruments for providing training in conducting experiments in Psychology and developing the skills required for administering and interpreting psychological tests of different kinds. The Laboratory also extends its support to the research activities undertaken by its faculty members, research scholars, and M.Ed. students for dissertations.

### Curriculum Lab

The college has a well-equipped curriculum laboratory which provides a place for the student teacher to engage in doing rather than being passive observers or recipients of knowledge for the teaching-learning process. It has various resources such as textbooks, an interactive whiteboard, Curriculum software packages, multi-disciplinary instructional materials, and supplementary educational material to support curriculum planning and developing lesson plans for creating various manipulatives needed to carry out a lesson. The student teachers can also use educational kits and games for class presentations.

### Library

The institute has a well-developed library with around 25000 books available for providing knowledge to students. The library is computerized, having *SOUL 2.0 software* for issues and return of books. The library is equipped with an online access process catalog (*OPEC*) with the help of software to search the books. It offers the students course-related books, reference books, magazines, journals, and newspapers so that the students can get updated about the market position and its demand in the modern era. Access to these books and periodicals is available during college hours. The book bank facility is open to the first 25 students on a first come first ,serve basis. E-resources are also available in the library.

### Academic Block

The academic block comprises 32 classrooms equipped with LCD Projectors and different types of laboratories. The entire academic block is wifi enabled and equipped with ultramodern facilities. Block contains one multipurpose hall of 2000 sqft. to conduct various types of in-house activities.

### Administrative Block

The Admin Block houses offices of the Principal, Secretary, Registrar, College Administration, Accounts Section, Teachers' Staff Rooms and Seminar Room with 5 multi-purpose small rooms. At the entry of the Admin Block a reception area welcomes the students, staff and other persons who seek to enquire about the college. The reception would be provided with an entire staff, with telephone and computer facility. The whole block has been specially painted and provided with new modular furniture. A pantry has also been provided in the Block.

Smart class nowadays is the essence of college. In this concern, the college has set up a SMART CLASS which provides e-learning e-lecture and media presentations to the students.

### Cafeteria

Our college campus has a cafeteria that runs during working hours and provides healthy and hygienic food to students and all staff members. The twenty-one-terminal lab is equipped with the latest, automated language lab system having the facility of voice recording, playback, one-on-one interaction etc. It is extremely beneficial for language learning and the enhancement of effective communication skills. The language lab is powered by Orell's digital language lab.

### Psychology Lab

The Psychology Laboratories at College has a large collection of psychological tests/ batteries and instruments for providing training in conducting experiments in Psychology and developing the skills required for administering and interpreting psychological tests of different kinds. The Laboratory also extends its support to the research activities undertaken by its faculty members, research scholars, and M.Ed. students for dissertations.

### Curriculum Lab

The college has a well-equipped curriculum laboratory which provides a place for the student teacher to engage in doing rather than being passive observers or recipients of knowledge for the teaching-learning process. It has various resources such as textbooks, an interactive whiteboard, Curriculum software packages, multi-disciplinary instructional materials, and supplementary educational material to support curriculum planning and developing lesson plans for creating various manipulatives needed to carry out a lesson. The student teachers can also use educational kits and games for class presentations.

### Library

The institute has a well-developed library with around 25000 books available for providing knowledge to students. The library is computerized, having *SOUL 2.0 software* for issues and return of books. The library is equipped with an online access process catalog (*OPEC*) with the help of software to search the books. It offers the students course-related books, reference books, magazines, journals, and newspapers so that the students can get updated about the market position and its demand in the modern era. Access to these books and periodicals is available during college hours. The book bank facility is open to the first 25 students on a first come first ,serve basis. E-resources are also available in the library.

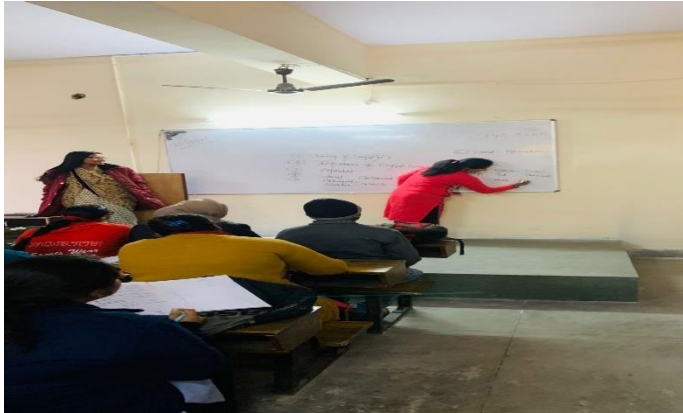

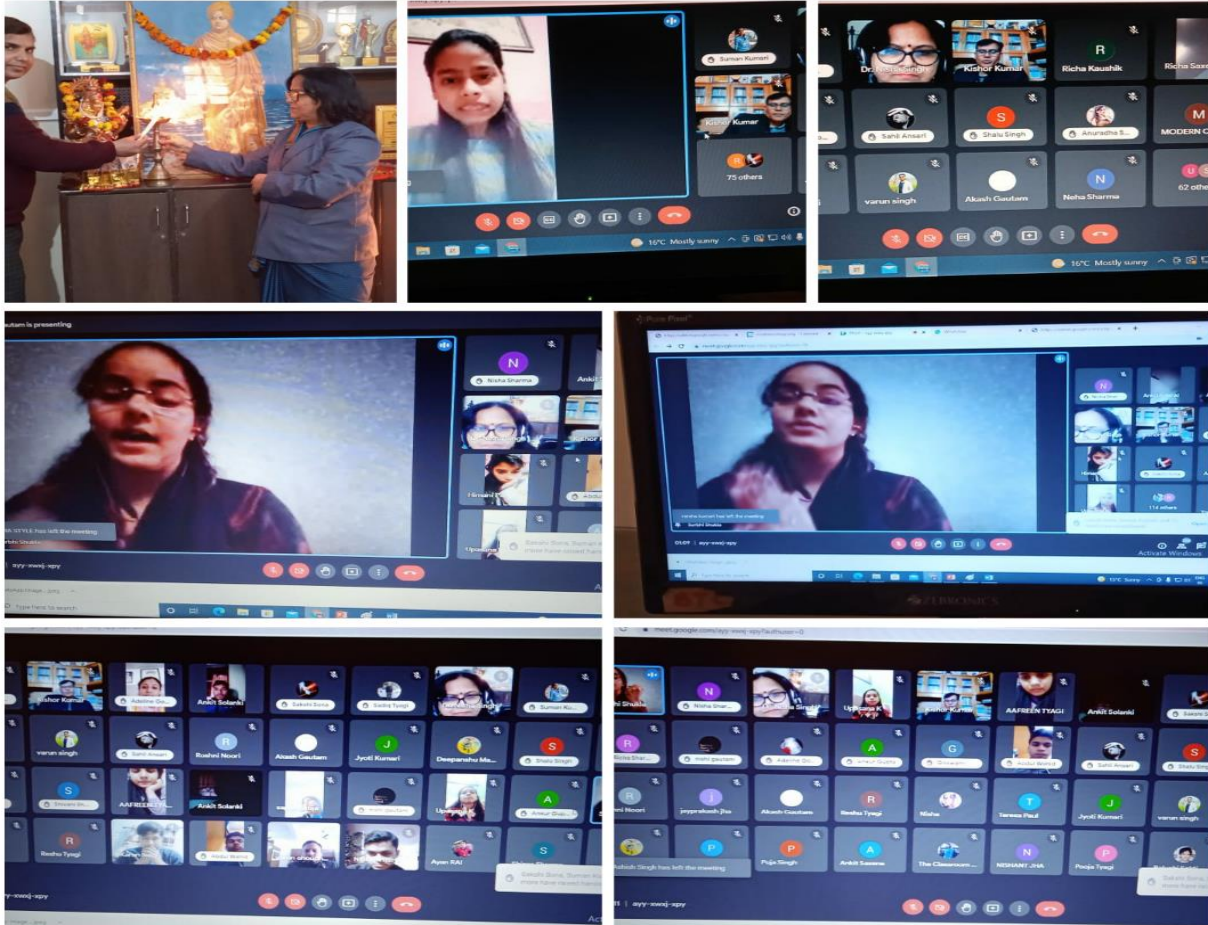

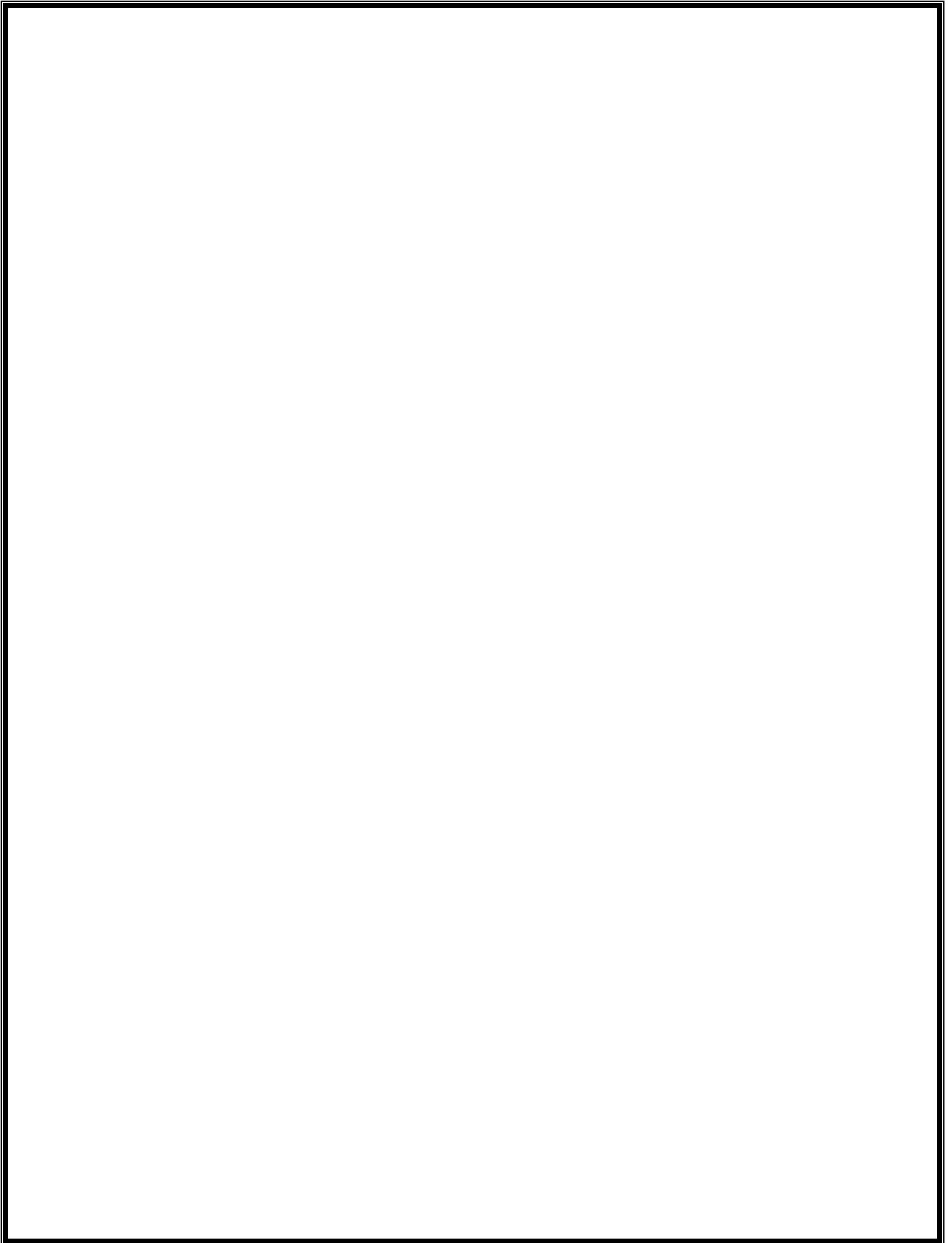


loved and admired. The focus of this day is to uphold the achievements of women from different walks of life, recognize their potential and challenges, thus focusing on women rights and gender equality.”

## **PLACEMENT CELL**

The Placement Cell operates yearly to facilitate contact with companies and institutions. The number of students placed through campus interviews is continuously rising.
